

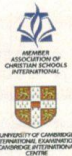

HEALTH CORNER

MONKEY POX

Introduction: Monkey pox is a rare infectious disease with less severe symptoms similar to those of small pox.

Causative Agent: Monkey virus.

Incubation period: 7-14 days, ranges between 5-21 days.

Primary mode of Spread: It is the direct contact with blood, body fluids or mucosal lesions of infected animals like monkey, Gambian giant rat, squirrel and rodent.

Secondary mode of Spread: Transmission is from Human-to-Human. Spread result from close contact with infected respiratory tract secretions, skin lesions, stools, blood and contaminated objects with body fluids or lesions.

Sign and Symptoms

- Fever – headache
- Muscle aches – chills
- Exhaustion – Rashes similar to those of small pox.

N.B: The difference between the two is that lymph nodes swells or enlarges in Monkey pox while small pox does not.

Prevention

- ✓ Avoid contact with dead animals, infected humans and their body fluids.
- ✓ Practice good hand hygiene with or without contact with infected animals or humans with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

Treatment

There's presently no known or proven safe treatment for Monkey pox.- Nurse Esther William
